## About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathway to independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

## Accommodation



### Accommodation type

A total of three bedrooms in a shared house with level access throughout. All part-furnished.



### Location

A quiet residential area of Chester, within walking distance of shops, leisure facilities, parks and public transport links.



### Communal areas

Kitchen, bathroom, lounge area, laundry room and garden.



### Safety and security

Staff office on-site part-time during office hours. Out of hours telephone service and CCTV to ensure residents' safety and security.



### Rental agreement type

All accommodation is let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

## Support

Staff draw up a personalised support plan with residents using the Life Star model to help residents to achieve their aims and goals.

Our highly trained staff are on-site part-time during office hours to deliver personalised support and meet residents' needs. There is an out-of-hours telephone service should residents require any further support.

We also provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently. Residents can purchase telecare technology to reduce their need for support whilst still feeling safe.

### Tailored support, advice and assistance includes:

- › Daily living skills
- › Maintaining a tenancy
- › Dealing with correspondence
- › Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- › Socialising and community involvement
- › Maintaining health, safety and security
- › Dealing with correspondence
- › Signposting and accessing other services
- › Maintaining appropriate behaviour and communication

## How to apply and eligibility

We accept referrals from the Adult Learning Disabilities team Cheshire West and Cheshire Council. All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

### To be eligible for a place at Gleneagles Close, applicants must:

- › Be aged 18 or over
- › Have a low to moderate learning disability
- › Have a minimum of 10.5 care and support hours per week
