About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathway to independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation type

Five one-bedroom flats. Each flat has a bedroom, an openplan kitchen, lounge, diner, and bathroom.



Technology

An emergency pull cord alarm system is fitted throughout the buildings, and personalised assistive technology is available.



Location

A residential area of New Milton, within walking distance of shops, restaurants, parks, colleges and public transport links.



Communal areas

A lounge, laundry room and garden.



Safety and security

The on-site staff office, with overnight sleep-in service, helps to ensure residents' safety and security.



Rental agreement type

Flats are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Care and Support

Our highly-trained staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents using the Life Star model. Staff are on-site during office hours, seven days a week. Overnight, staff are nearby and available in case of an emergency, plus additional telephone support from management, should residents need any further support.

We work closely with local health care professionals to achieve the best outcomes for residents with changing needs. Working with the integrated learning disability team within health care and social services, we support residents to access specialist services and technology to promote their independence and reduce their need for support whilst still feeling safe.

Tailored support, advice and assistance includes:

- Managing personal care and medication
- Maintaining a tenancy
- > Positive behaviour management
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- > Maintaining health, safety and security
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Building positive relationships
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Managing nutrition and hydration needs

How to apply and eligibility

To apply directly, please request an application form. We also accept referrals from Hampshire Social Services. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Old Milton Road, applicants must:

- > Have a learning disability
- Be aged 18 or over
