At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation type

10 part-furnished studio apartments and two part-furnished one-bedroom apartments, each with a bedroom, lounge/diner, kitchen and shower room.



Location

Clifton, close to shops and other city-centre amenities, as well as the Queen Elizabeth's Hospital and public transport connections.



Communal areas

A shared lounge, laundry room and garden.



Technology

We can provide assistive technology for extra safety and reassurance, which can be purchased at additional cost.



Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system help to ensure tenants safety and security.

All apartments are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Support

Everyone is supported to achieve greater independence. Staff draw up a personalised support plan with tenants using the Mental Health Recovery Star model. Our highly-trained staff are on-site during office hours to suit tenants needs, giving tenants peace of mind that support is on-hand.

There is an out-of-hours telephone service, should tenants require any further support Residents can also purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence.

Tailored care, support and assistance includes:

- › Maintaining a tenancy
- › Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- › Accessing education, training and work
- › Building positive relationships
- › Developing hobbies and interests
- › Building confidence, resilience and self-esteem
- › Socialising and community involvement
- › Maintaining health, safety and security
- › Signposting and accessing other services
- › Planning a successful move-on

How to apply and eligibility

To apply directly, please complete our online enquiry form and ask for an application form. We also accept referrals from the adult social care team at Bristol City Council. All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Stoneleigh House, applicants must be:

- › Be aged 18 to 65
- › Have a mental health need
- › Be receiving support from the Community Mental Health Team (CMHT)
- › Be assessed as having a need under the Care Act 2014
