Set in the Greater Manchester town of Eccles, Wellington Road offers 11 en-suite rooms in a shared house, as well as two self-contained one bedroom flats. We provide support for adults aged 18 and over, with a range of mental health needs, encouraging them to develop their skills and live as independently as possible.

About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation



Accommodation type

11 fully-furnished en-suite rooms in a shared house along with two furnished one-bedroom flats.



Location

In the town centre, close to Eccles Railway Station and within walking distance of shops, supermarkets, restaurants and leisure facilities.



Communal areas

A lounge, dining room, kitchen, laundry room and level-access garden.



Technology

Free Wi-Fi in communal areas. We can provide assistive technology for extra safety and reassurance, which can be purchased at additional cost.



Safety and security

A staff office, CCTV, a secure door access system and security staff on-site.



Rental agreement type

The bedrooms are let on an excluded licence agreement and the flats are let on a protected licence agreement.

Support

Staff draw up a personalised support plan with residents using the Mental Health Recovery Star model. Our highly-trained staff are on-site 9am-5pm every day and there is an overnight concierge service and out-of-hours telephone service, should residents require any further support.

Residents can also purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence. We also provide move-on support to help prepare residents for living independently as well as floating support to people living in the local area.

Tailored care, support and assistance includes:

- Daily living skills
- Maintaining a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Accessing education, training and employment
- Dealing with correspondence
- Socialising and community involvement
- Managing mental health needs
- Building confidence, resilience and self-esteem
- Maintaining appropriate behaviour and good communication

How to apply and eligibility

We accept referrals from Salford Community Mental Health team or Salford City Council's Adult Social Care team. All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Wellington Road, applicants must:

- Be aged 18 or over
- Have a diagnosed mental health need
