At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathway to independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Eight fully-furnished bedrooms in a shared house.



Location

Bridgwater, close to shops, leisure facilities and public transport links.



Communal areas

A lounge with TV, kitchen, bathroom, laundry room and garden. Wi-Fi is available throughout.



Technology

Integrated emergency pull cord alarm system throughout, for reassurance and to support independence.



Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system to ensure Drawbridge House is a safe and secure place to live.

All bedrooms are let on an excluded license agreement.

Support

Everyone is supported to achieve greater independence. Staff draw up a personalised support plan with residents using the Life Star model. Staff support residents to manage and improve their personal safety and improve social, emotional and mental wellbeing. We also provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently.

Our highly-trained staff are on-site 24 hours a day, seven days a week, giving residents peace of mind that assistance is always on-hand. Residents can purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence.

Tailored support, advice and assistance includes:

- › Daily living skills
- › Maintaining a tenancy
- › Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- › Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- › Building positive relationships
- › Managing nutrition and hydration needs
- › Developing hobbies and interests
- › Maintaining health, safety and security
- › Signposting and accessing other services

How to apply and eligibility

To apply, please complete an application form. We also accept referrals from Somerset County Council and Sedgemoor District Council. All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Drawbridge House, applicants must be:

- › Be aged 18 to 65
- › Have a learning disability
