At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation



Location

A residential area on the outskirts of Canterbury, within walking distance of shops, leisure facilities and public transport links.



Accommodation type

Six bedrooms spread across two attached, self-contained bungalows.



Communal areas

A lounge, accessible kitchen, dining room, activity room, sensory room, accessible bathroom and level-access garden.



Technology

Free Wi-Fi in communal areas. Integrated emergency pull cord alarm system throughout and personal pendant alarm available. A hoist system, bed sensors and door sensors help to maintain independence.



Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system help to ensure residents' safety and security.



Rental agreement type

All bedrooms are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Support

Staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents helping them to identify their needs and aspirations. We can provide 24-hour care and support, including personal care, depending on individual needs.

Our highly-trained staff are on-site 24 hours a day, seven days a week, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand. There is also an out-of-hours telephone service, should residents require any further support. Residents can also purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence.

Tailored care support and assistance includes:

- Daily living skills and managing a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Dealing with correspondence
- Building positive relationships
- Managing personal care and medication
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Managing nutrition and hydration needs
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services

How to apply and eligibility

To apply, please complete our online enquiry form and ask for an application form. We also accept referrals from Kent County Council. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Sussex Avenue, applicants must be:

- Be aged 18 to 65
- Have a learning disability or physical disability
