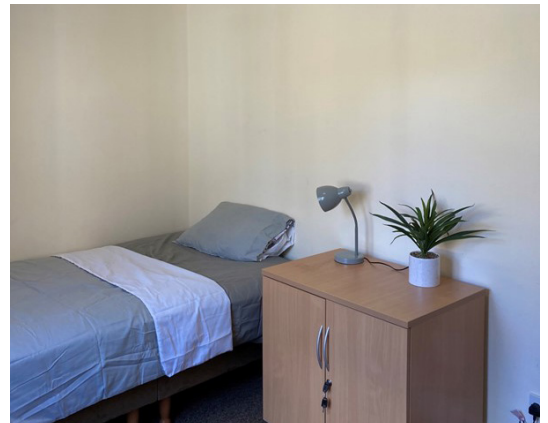

About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation type

Five partly furnished single-occupancy bedrooms in a shared house with furnished communal areas spread across two floors.



Location

Within walking distance of shops, leisure facilities, parks and excellent links with Transport for London.



Communal areas

A lounge, accessible kitchen, laundry room, garden and shared bathroom.



Technology

Communal Wi-Fi is available to all residents in communal areas. We can provide assistive technology for extra safety and reassurance, which can be purchased at additional cost.



Safety and security

Staff office onsite, secure door entry system and telephone out of hours support available to ensure residents' safety and security.



Rental agreement type

All bedrooms are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Support

Staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents using the Life Star model. Our highly-trained staff are on-site in the main office and available most days between 8am and 8pm, depending on residents' needs, giving residents peace of mind that support is on-hand. There is an out-of-hours telephone service, should residents require any additional support.

We also provide follow-on support when residents move out of Compton Road to live independently. Residents can purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence.

Tailored support and assistance includes:

- Maintaining a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Daily living skills
- Managing personal care and medication
- Building confidence, resilience and self-esteem
- Dealing with correspondence
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services

How to apply and eligibility

Complete our online enquiry form and ask to speak to the manager to arrange an assessment. We accept referrals from Enfield Council, as well as out-of-borough referrals.

All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Compton Road, applicants must:

- Be aged 18 to 65
- Be mobile and able to climb stairs
- Require care for a minimum of 5 hours per week
