Old Liverpool Road, Warrington, has 10 bedrooms in a shared house. We provide support for adults aged 18 and over, with a range of mental health needs. Residents are encouraged to take control of their lives and build on their skills and strengths.

- Staff on-site during office hours, seven days a week
- Short-term supported housing for up to a year
- Communal lounge, kitchen, bathroom, laundry room and garden

## About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

## Accommodation



### Accommodation type

10 fully-furnished bedrooms in a shared house. Two ground floor rooms have en-suite facilities.



### Location

Close to Warrington town centre, within walking distance of shops, supermarkets, leisure facilities, parks and public transport links.



### Communal areas

A lounge, kitchen, bathroom, laundry room and garden, with Wi-Fi throughout.



### Technology

We can provide assistive technology for extra safety and reassurance, which can be purchased at additional cost.



### Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system help to ensure residents' safety and security.



### Rental agreement type

All rooms are let on a licence agreement.

## Support

Everyone is supported to achieve greater independence. Staff draw up a personalised support plan with residents using the Mental Health Recovery Star model

Our highly-trained staff are on-site during office hours, seven days a week, giving residents peace of mind that support is on-hand. There is an overnight concierge service seven days a week, and an out-of-hours telephone service, should residents require any further support. We provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently. We also offer community support to people living in the local area, which is available through the Complex Case panel at Warrington Borough Council.

### Tailored support and assistance includes:

- Daily living skills
- Maintaining a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Accessing education, training and work
- Dealing with correspondence
- Socialising and community involvement
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Planning a successful move-on

## How to apply and eligibility

We accept referrals from the Adult Social Care and Mental Health Recovery teams at Warrington Borough Council.

All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

### To be eligible for a place at Old Liverpool Road, applicants must be:

- Aged 18 or over
- Have a diagnosed mental health need
- In receipt of a personal budget
