At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Seven unfurnished en-suite bedrooms in a shared house, spread across four floors.



Free Wi-Fi in communal areas. Integrated emergency pull cord alarm system throughout and personal pendant alarm available.



Location

A quiet area of Malvern, close to the Malvern Hills, as well as shops, supermarkets, public transport connections and other local amenities.



Safety and security

Staff office on site, CCTV and a secure door access system help to ensure residents feel safe and secure.



Communal areas

A lounge, kitchen, dining area, computer room and spacious garden.



Rental agreement type

All bedrooms are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Support

Everyone is supported to achieve greater independence. Staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents using the Life Star model. We can provide 24-hour care and support, including personal care, depending on individual needs. Our highly-trained staff are on-site 24 hours a day, seven days a week, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand. There is an out-of-hours telephone service, should residents require any further support.

We also provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently. Residents can purchase telecare technology to reduce their need for support whilst still feeling safe.

Tailored support and assistance includes:

- Daily living skills
- Maintaining tenancy
- Managing personal care and medication
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- > Dealing with correspondence
- > Socialising and community involvement
- > Building positive relationships
- Maintaining appropriate behaviour and good communication
- Signposting and accessing other services
