At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation



Accommodation type

18 unfurnished one-bedroom apartments spread across three floors, with level access throughout the building.



Location

Close to Arnos Park, with easy access to local shops, New Southgate train station, Arnos Grove tube station and bus stops.



Communal areas

A lounge and shared garden.



Technology

Free Wi-Fi in communal areas. Integrated Tunstall assistive technology system and personal pendant alarm available.



Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system are used to ensure residents feel safe and secure.



Rental agreement type

All apartments are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Support

Staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents using the Life Star model. We can provide 24-hour care and support, including personal care, depending on individual needs. Our highly-trained staff are on-site 24 hours a day, seven days a week, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand.

Residents can purchase assistive technology to reduce their need for support whilst still feeling safe.

We also provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently, as well as providing floating support to people living in the local area.

Tailored support, advice and assistance includes:

- Daily living skills
- Managing personal care and medication
- Maintaining a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Building confidence, resilience and self-esteem
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Managing nutrition and hydration needs
- Socialising and community involvement
- Managing rent and rent arrears
- Maintaining appropriate behaviour and good communication

How to apply and eligibility

We accept referrals from the Brokerage Team at Barnet Council.

All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Sarnes Court, applicants must:

- Be aged 18 to 65
- Have a learning disability
