Located in a quiet, residential street, Clacton-on-Sea Homelessness Supported Housing comprises of nine rooms in a shared house. We provide support for single homeless adults aged 18-64.

- ▶ Short-term supported housing
- ▶ Communal facilities include a kitchen, dining area and lounge

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation



Accommodation type

A nine-bedroom, fully furnished shared house.



Rental agreement type

All bedrooms are let on an excluded licence agreement.



Communal areas

A lounge, kitchen, laundry room and garden.



Technology

We can provide assistive technology for extra safety and reassurance, purchased at additional cost.



Safety and security

An overnight concierge service, CCTV and a secure door access system to ensure residents' safety and security.



Location

Near the beach and town centre with easy access to local amenities including supermarkets and public transport.

Support

Our highly trained staff draw up a personalised support plan with residents using the Home Star model, to help them achieve their aims and goals.

Staff are on-site between 9am-8pm, Monday-Friday, and 10am-3pm at alternate weekends. There is also an overnight concierge service.

All residents have access to an out-of-hours telephone service, should they need further support.

Tailored care, support and assistance includes:

- Maintaining a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Daily living skills
- Building positive relationships
- Accessing education, training and work
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Dealing with correspondence
- Socialising and community involvement
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Planning a successful move-on
- Managing mental health needs

How to apply and eligibility

To apply directly, please contact us for an application form. We also accept referrals from Tendring District Council. To apply, visit their website and search for 'homelessness advice'.

All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Clacton-on-Sea Homelessness Supported Housing, applicants must:

- Be aged 18 to 64
- Be homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Have a recognised support need

Residents can purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence.
