


Our taste restaurant is open seven days a week for breakfast, lunch and snacks*.


It is open to the public so you can enjoy a meal with your friends and family.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible to live at Dunboyne Court, you must:

- Be aged 55 or over, or have longterm care needs
- > Reside in the local area
- Have your care and support needs assessed and approved by Torbay and South Devon NHS Foundation Trust

We aim to offer a lively atmosphere and mixed community of people who have a range of care needs. Dunboyne Court may not be suitable if you require a substantial amount of regular nursing care.



How much does it cost?


For full pricing information, please see our current price list. We have options for private or local authoritypaid rent agreements, and leasehold agreements.

As well as your rent or leasehold costs, you will need to pay:

- A peace of mind charge for your 24-hour pull cord alert system (leaseholders only)
- A service charge, which covers your heating and water usage, maintenance costs and utilities charges for the communal areas and gardens, and buildings insurance for leasehold properties
- Fees for any care and support services you require, which may be paid for by Torbay Council, if you have had your needs assessed and approved by the adult social care team

You will also be responsible for paying for council tax (band C or D), electricity usage, TV licence (if applicable) and any additional television package, telephone and line rental, internet and contents insurance.

Meals, snacks and drinks in our **taste** restaurant, and overnight stays in our guest suite for visitors are all charged separately.



How do I apply?

- 1. Contact us for an application form, or contact Torbay Council's adult social care team.
- 2. We'll arrange for you to visit and meet us.
- 3. While you're here, the onsite care provider may assess if you would benefit from their care and support services and arrange to visit you at home to discuss your needs. For your care to be funded by Torbay Council, you must have had your needs assessed and approved by the adult social care team.
