About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation



13 self-contained and part-furnished one-bedroom flats spread across two floors. Two flats have accessible bathrooms.



Integrated emergency pull cord alarm system throughout and personal pendant alarm available.



A quiet, residential area of Winshill, two miles from Burton-on-Trent town centre, within reach of shops, supermarkets, Newton park and a bus stop.

Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system to ensure residents' safety and security and an out-of-hours telephone service.



Communal lounge, kitchen and a garden.



All flats are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Support

Staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents using the Life Star model. Our highly-trained staff are on-site 10 hours a day, seven days a week, with an out-of-hours telephone service, should residents require further support.

We also provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently, as well as providing floating support to people living in the local area. Residents can purchase additional telecare technology to further promote their independence.

Tailored support and assistance includes:

- Maintaining a tenancy
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- > Building confidence, resilience and self-esteem
- > Developing hobbies and interests
- > Dealing with correspondence
- > Accessing education, training and work
- > Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Planning a successful move-on

How to apply and eligibility

To apply, contact us for an application form. We also accept referrals from Staffordshire County Council.

All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Epworth House, applicants must be:

- > Be 18 or over
- > Have a learning disability or autism
