Tenure	Assured non-shorthold tenancy agreement
Subletting	Subletting is not permitted
Nomination arrangements	100% nominations agreement in place with Torbay Council
Care provider	Agincare
Insurance	Buildings insurance, public liability insurance and employers' liability insurance are all covered by Sanctuary
Charges when moving into the property	
Deposit	Four week's total charge (rent, service charge and peace of mind charge) is payable on moving in day.
Other	Removal costs
Ongoing charges payable to the operator	
Rent	Due four weekly in advance – the cost will vary depending on the number of bedrooms, apartment size and location, as well as your eligibility for financial assistance
Service charge	Due four weekly in advance – the cost will vary depending on your eligibility for financial assistance. It covers your 24-hour pull cord alert system, your heating and water usage, maintenance costs and utilities charges for the communal areas and gardens
Overnight 'on call' support	Included in the service charge
Ground rent	Not applicable for rental properties

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Ongoing charges payable to external organisations	
Utility bills	The cost of electricity used in your apartment is payable directly to your utility supplier of choice, and your personal heating and water usage is covered in your service charge
Council tax	Band C or D, payable by you directly to Torbay Council
TV licence	Communal Licence
Telephone and internet	Line rental, telephone charges and internet charges are payable by you directly to your provider of choice
TV package	Any additional television package in your apartment is payable by you directly to your provider of choice
Contents insurance	Payable by you directly to your insurance provider of choice

Care and support	Available from Agincare, please contact them directly for prices
Nursing care	Available from external providers, GP, social services
Domestic services	Available from your provider of choice
Charges when leaving the property	
Repairs and redecoration	The cost of any repairs or redecoration needed in Sanctuary view to make the property suitable for re-letting
Other costs	Any rent, service charge or sundry debts due up to the end of the tenancy
Eligibility requirements
