

We provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support. We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

CARE AND SUPPORT

We have extensive experience in supporting people with learning disabilities who require support with their everyday needs, encouraging them to develop their skills and live as independently as possible.

Our structured package of tailored support uses the Life Star model to agree a personalised support plan, helping residents to identify their needs and aspirations. Their progress is regularly monitored and reviewed with the plan updated to reflect any changing needs. All support is designed to help residents achieve good emotional health and improve their wellbeing and quality of life. Our highly-trained staff provide a wide range of tailored support, advice and assistance, including:

- Day-to-day general needs
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Dealing with correspondence
- Managing personal care and medication
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services

Staff are on-site 24 hours a day, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand. We also provide follow-on care and support when residents move on to live independently.

ACCOMMODATION

Located in a quiet, residential area of Malvern, Albert Park Road is within walking distance of local shops, a post office, leisure facilities and public transport links.

Spread over four floors, there are seven single-occupancy en-suite rooms. Residents are encouraged to add personal touches, such as pictures or ornaments, to make their rooms feel more homely. The communal areas include a kitchen with laundry facilities, a dining room, two lounges and a shared garden, providing residents with space to relax in peace and quiet, or to socialise with others.

CCTV and an intercom door access system are in place to help to ensure residents' safety and security.

HOW TO APPLY AND ELIGIBILITY

We accept referrals from the Positive Living Options team at Worcestershire County Council, who can be contacted on 01905 843 895. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

Applicants must be aged 18 - 65 and have a diagnosed learning disability.
