

We provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support. We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

CARE AND SUPPORT

We have extensive experience in supporting adults aged 18 or over, with learning disabilities, encouraging them to develop their skills and live as independently as possible.

Our structured package of tailored support uses the Life Star model to agree a personalised support plan, helping residents to identify their needs and aspirations. Their progress is regularly monitored and reviewed, with the plan updated to reflect any changing needs. All support is designed to help residents achieve good emotional health and improve their wellbeing and quality of life. Our highly-trained staff provide a wide range of tailored support, advice and assistance, including:

- Daily living skills
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Positive behaviour management
- Managing personal care and medication
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Managing nutrition and hydration needs

Staff are on-site 24 hours a day and an emergency pull-cord system is installed throughout, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand.

ACCOMMODATION

Located in a quiet, residential area of Mansfield, Corner House is within walking distance of the town centre, close to Titchfield Park, local colleges and a cinema, and has good public transport links.

There are 11 fully-furnished en-suite bedrooms, spread over two floors. The communal areas include a lounge, dining room, kitchen, activity room, bathroom, laundry room and garden. Bed sensors and door sensors are used to help residents to maintain their independence. CCTV and a secure door access system are in place to ensure residents' safety and security.

We also run a floating support service, based in the Mansfield and Ashfield area, supporting people with learning disabilities in their own homes and in the community.

HOW TO APPLY AND ELIGIBILITY

We accept referrals from Nottinghamshire County Council's Local Community Learning Disability team and from Nottingham City Council, as well as direct self-referrals. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

Applicants must be aged 18 or over, have a learning disability and require residential care.
