We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

## CARE AND SUPPORT

We have extensive experience in supporting adults who have medium-level mental health needs, encouraging them to develop their skills and live as independently as possible.

Our structured package of tailored support uses the Mental Health Recovery Star model to agree a personal support plan, enabling residents to identify their needs and achieve their goals. Their progress is regularly monitored and reviewed with the plan updated to reflect any changing needs. Residents at all Greenwich Care Services schemes can receive CQC-registered care and support for up to two years. All schemes offer environments where residents are encouraged to take control of their lives by building on their skills and strengths. Our highly-trained staff offer a wide range of tailored support, advice and assistance, including:

- Maintaining good health and a healthy lifestyle
- Managing finance and welfare benefits
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Accessing education, training and employment
- Dealing with correspondence
- Socialising and community

Staff are available on-site at all schemes from 9am to 9pm and there is an overnight concierge service, in case residents require support.

## ACCOMMODATION

Our schemes in Greenwich are located in quiet residential areas, all within walking distance of shops, public transport links and leisure facilities.

Victoria Way, a 14-bedroom shared house, and Herbert Road, a six-bedroom shared house, are both fully-furnished properties with communal living areas, bathrooms and gardens. Self-contained furnished accommodation is available at Burnt Ash Hill (five flats), Landsdowne Lane (seven flats) and Manor Park (eight flats). These schemes also have communal areas and residents are encouraged to socialise with others from across all the schemes and use all the communal facilities.

CCTV and a secure door entry system are used at all schemes to ensure residents' safety and security.

### HOW TO APPLY AND ELIGIBILITY

We accept referrals from Greenwich Council. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

Applicants must be aged 18 - 65 and have diagnosed mental health needs.
