## CARE AND SUPPORT

**We have extensive experience in supporting people with learning disabilities who require support with their everyday needs, encouraging them to develop their skills and live as independently as possible.**

Our structured package of tailored support uses the Life Star model to agree a personalised support plan, helping residents to identify their needs and aspirations. Their progress is regularly monitored and reviewed with the plan updated to reflect any changing needs. All support is designed to help residents achieve good emotional health and improve their wellbeing and quality of life. Our highly-trained staff provide a wide range of tailored support, advice and assistance, including:

- Day-to-day general needs
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Dealing with correspondence
- Managing personal care and medication
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Signposting and accessing other services

Staff are on-site 24 hours a day, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand.

## ACCOMMODATION

**Hazel Court is located on Sanctuary Grove, which is a short drive from Worcester city centre and St John's, which has a library, attractive parks, shops and cafes.**

Spread over two floors with level access throughout, there are 14 self-contained apartments, which have a bedroom, lounge with TV point, fitted kitchen and level access bathroom. The communal areas include a lounge, kitchen, sensory room and gardens with raised beds, providing space to relax in peace and quiet, or socialise with others. Residents also have access to the facilities at the nearby Retirement Living scheme, Noble House, including a cafe and hairdressing salon.

An emergency pull-cord system is installed throughout and an intercom secure access system helps to ensure residents' safety and security.

### HOW TO APPLY AND ELIGIBILITY

We accept referrals from the Positive Living Options team at Worcestershire County Council, who can be contacted on 01905 768 053. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

Applicants must be aged 18 - 65 and have a diagnosed learning disability.
