At Sanctuary Supported Living we deliver personalised care and support services to help people on their pathway to independence.

We provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support. We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.



CARE AND SUPPORT

Our services in Anglesea road, Berners Street, Cecil Road and Langley Close provide supported housing to young people and single adults in Ipswich and Felixstowe.

We offer safe and modern environments where residents are encouraged to take control of their lives and build on their skills and strengths. Our highly-trained staff provide a package of tailored support services, based on the Outcomes Star model, which enables residents to live independently and achieve their personal goals. Progress is regularly monitored and reviewed, with the plan updated to reflect any changing needs.

The range of personalised support, advice and assistance available includes:

- Maintaining a tenancy
- Daily living skills
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Dealing with correspondence
- Accessing education, training and work
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Planning a successful move-on

Staff are available seven days a week during office hours, with overnight security on-hand at Anglesea Road and Langley Close for added peace of mind. All residents also have access to an out-of-hours telephone service should they need further support.

ACCOMMODATION

Our services in Ipswich are located in quiet residential areas within the town centre. Langley Close is within walking distance of Felixstowe town centre and the seafront. All residents have easy access to public transport, local amenities, leisure facilities and external services.

Anglesea Road offers 14 furnished bedrooms in a hostel, as well as four self-contained fully-furnished flats in a separate building. Cecil Road has three furnished bedrooms in a shared house and residents have access to a communal kitchen, lounge/diner and garden. Accommodation at Berners Street includes a furnished two-bedroom flat and 12 unfurnished single-occupancy flats. Langley Close offers three one-bedroom furnished flats and 6 two-bedroom furnished flats.

Applicants must be aged 16 - 65 and have a recognised support need.
