About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathway to independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Accommodation



Accommodation type

17 unfurnished, one-bedroom apartments, each with a spacious bedroom, an open-plan kitchen, dining and lounge area and a level access shower room.



Location

Located in Eston Community Village within walking distance of shops, bus stops and leisure facilities.



Communal areas

A large communal lounge and landscaped garden.



Technology

Integrated emergency pull cord alarm system throughout and personal pendant alarm available. WiFi in all communal areas.



Safety and security

Staff office on-site, CCTV and a secure door access system help to ensure residents' safety and security.



Rental agreement type

All apartments are let on an assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Care and Support

Everyone is supported to achieve greater independence. Staff draw up a personalised care and support plan with residents using the Life Star model. Their progress is regularly monitored and reviewed, and their plan updated to reflect any changing needs. Romanby Crescent has a supportive environment where residents are encouraged to take control of their lives by building on their skills and strengths.

Our highly-trained staff are on-site 24 hours a day, seven days a week, giving residents peace of mind that support is always on-hand.

Tailored support, advice and assistance includes:

- Maintaining a tenancy, managing rent
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Socialising and community involvement
- Building confidence, resilience and self-esteem
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Accessing education, training and employment
- Dealing with correspondence
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Planning a successful move-on

We also provide follow-on support when residents move on to live independently. Residents can purchase additional assistive technology to further promote their independence.

How to apply and eligibility

To apply, complete Middlesbrough Council's application for housing-related support. We also accept direct referrals. All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Romanby Crescent, applicants must:

- Be aged 18 or over
- Have a learning disability or mental health need
