Sanctuary Supported Living delivers personalised care and support services to help people on their pathway to independence.

We provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support. We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.



CARE AND SUPPORT

At Skelton Court, we have extensive experience in supporting people with learning and physical disabilities, dual diagnosis, sensory impairments and degenerative conditions such as dementia.

Our structured package of tailored support, based on the Life Star model, agrees a personalised support plan, helping residents to identify their needs and aspirations. We encourage residents to develop their confidence, build on their skills and strengths, and live as independently as possible. Their progress is regularly reviewed with the plan updated to reflect any changing needs. Our highly-trained staff are on-site 24 hours a day to offer support, advice and assistance, including:

- Maintaining health, safety and security
- Developing hobbies and interests
- Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- Managing nutritional and hydration needs
- Positive behaviour management
- Building positive relationships

There are a range of options to access activities both in the home and in the wider community. Additional funding may be required to provide one-to-one support in the community.

ACCOMMODATION

Skelton Court is an attractive single storey building within walking distance of shops, leisure facilities and a bus route which offers easy access to the town centre.

Each resident has their own spacious en-suite bedroom, which they can furnish and decorate as they choose, as well as access to beautifully designed communal spaces. The home is fully wheelchair-accessible and accommodates a range of mobility needs. A bespoke nurse call system is installed throughout to provide emergency support when needed and offers residents personalised assistive technology.

A range of communication and sensory techniques are in place to boost residents' independence, including objects of reference, sequencing aids and pictorial materials to assist in decision making. Colour palettes, furnishings and accessories are designed to assist with safe orientation and control, including consistent floor colours to reduce the risk of falls, contrasting furniture to aid visual cues to transfer safely and distinctive door colours to identify different areas.

An intercom system, fob access, front of house office and meeting area to welcome visitors helps to make Skelton Court a safe and secure place to live, as well as ensure that residents' privacy and dignity is respected.

HOW TO APPLY AND ELIGIBILITY

We accept referrals from local authorities in Leicester and Leicestershire, as well as direct self-referrals. All care and support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

Applicants must be aged 18-65 and have a learning disability with high or critical needs.
